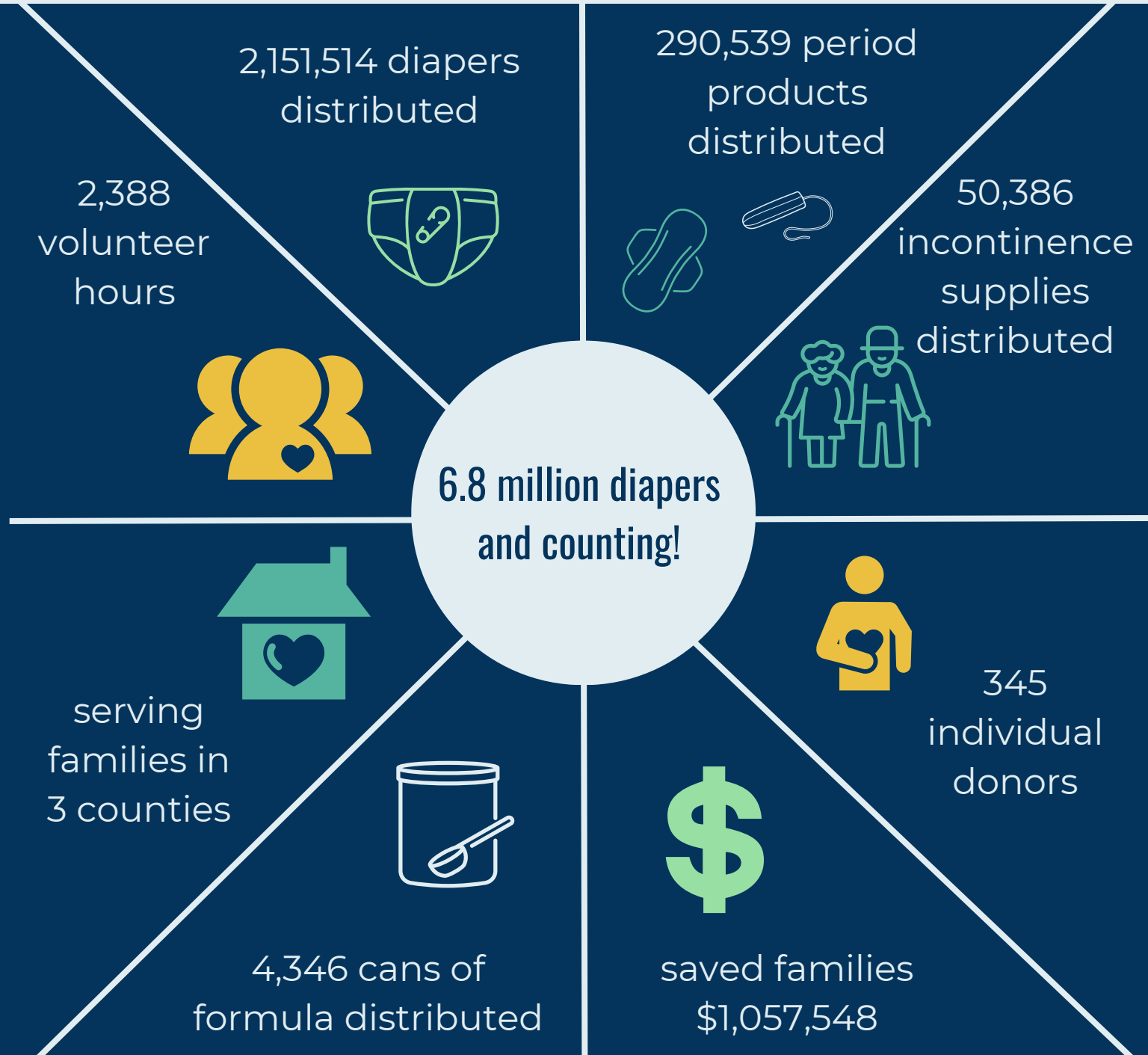


2022 Annual Report

Collaborated with SisterFriend, Inc. to host our first community period product distribution, giving out 22,000 products.

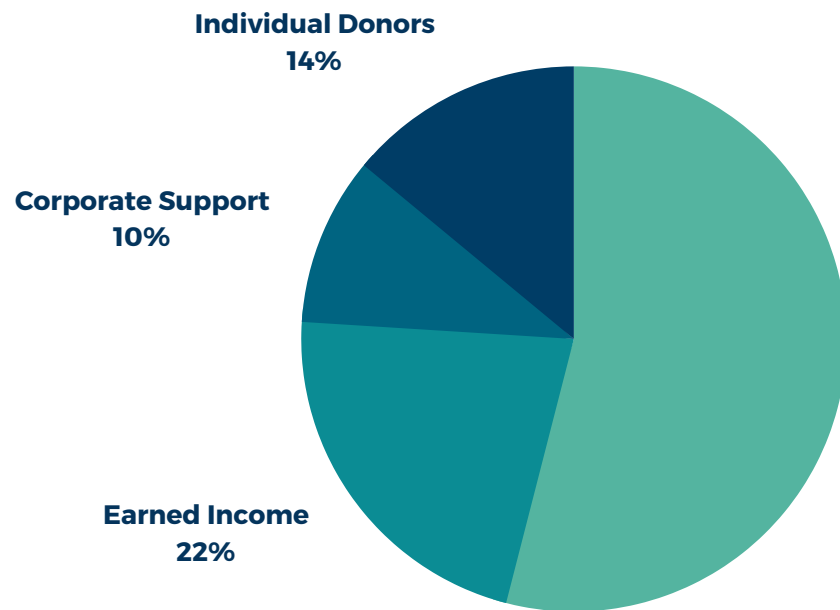


Period Advocacy Project
